

## Membership Requirements

Membership of the Laser 2000 Class Association is a prerequisite for entry to the major events facilitated by the Class Association. These include National & Inland Championships, Millennium Series and Euro Cup events. Membership of the Class Association is not required for 'Open' meetings, but is encouraged by host clubs.

Full membership includes Individual, Group and Corporate categories. Individual membership is only £15 and carries with it a host of benefits. Further details can be found on the Laser 2000 website.

Individual membership is deemed to include spouses and any children under 21 in full time education, sailing together in any combination, or any one sailing with ANOther, but only covering one boat at any one time. Two boats in the same event will require two memberships.

Membership is not mandatory for Training events where the Class Association provides the coaches or trainers, but non-members will incur a charge for the coaching or training. N.B. This arrangement does not include the Weymouth Coaching weekend, where additional coaches and facilities are provided by *SailLaser*.

## Youth Entries & Training Events

Noble Marine Insurance and the Class Association encourage the ongoing development of youth and junior sailors and welcome their participation in Laser 2000 events.



In line with the above, for those major events facilitated by the Class Association, Youth (under 21 and in full time education) entries meeting the above membership requirements will be able to take advantage of reduced entry fees; a 25% discount for a Youth helm and a 50% discount for Youth helm and crew.

Likewise, training events where the Class Association provides the Trainer in conjunction with the host club will be free of charge to Association members. In particular, this arrangement does not include the Weymouth Coaching weekend.

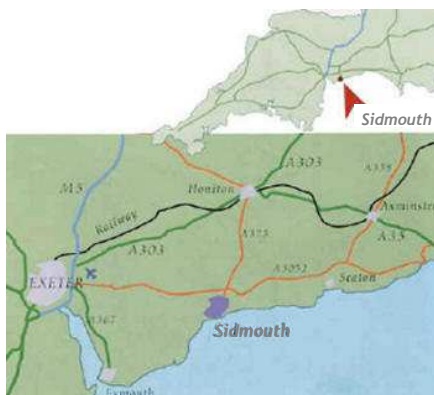
