- Severe headache
- Blurred vision
- Unusual drowsiness
- Change in behaviour/confusion
- Nausea or repeated vomiting
- Clumsy walking, staggering, dizziness
- Unresponsiveness
- Slurred speech
- Bleeding or fluid from the ears or nose

Watching television or a computer screen is not recommended during this period.

Contact your family doctor or accident and emergency department immediately if you notice any of the above symptoms.
